Have guests RSVP with their choice of Entrée. It will save time when guests take their seats after Cocktail Hour.

I. CEREMONY

NOTES

The Atmosphere: If you have a specific theme for your Prelude, share that playlist with me. Whether it's cinematic strings or acoustic covers, we'll set the stage before the first guest even takes a seat.

The Moment: For traditional weddings, the Officiant leads the way, followed by the Groom. When the **Bride's March** begins, that's when the magic happens.

III. RECEPTION - B. & C. DANCES

NOTES

Usually Parent's Dances are shorter than the 1st Dance song. Let DJ Maxx know exactly where you want the song to fade out.

If you wish to include a Bride and Mother dance, surprise your Mother with a special dance prior to your Cake Cutting.

PRO TIP

Your photographers will love you if you dance through your entire First Dance song. It gives them the time to capture every angle of that "just married" glow.

Short & Sweet: I always encourage Best Men and Maids of Honor to keep toasts "Short & Sweet". It keeps the momentum high and the guests engaged.

To keep your timeline on track, the microphone is reserved strictly for those on our pre-approved Event Manifest. No surprise "open mic" moments here—I've got your back.

Usually I will encourage the Bride and Groom to say a quick thank you speech to all the guests prior to Cake Cutting.

The Garter Twist

For the Garter Toss, let's get creative. Instead of the traditional garter, consider throwing a gift card, a football, or even a box of your favorite spirits.

The "One More Song" Tradition
