PRO TIP

If your venue is going to serve tons of Cocktail Hour Food and drinks at an Open Bar The Cocktail Food Burner will be perfect for guests ready to party immediately.

I. CEREMONY

Your Soundtrack

Submit your custom theme for the Prelude, and I'll handle the rest.

The Modern Entrance

I often recommend making the Processional optional. The Officiant and Groom start at the front, and the Bride is the first to march in—this streamlines the start and gets everyone to the Open Bar faster!

Forget the "cookie-cutter" wedding tracks. I want you to choose songs that truly resonate with your unique story.

II. COCKTAIL HOUR

Seamless Audio: I'll discreetly hide a speaker in the room so the music fills the air without ever distracting from the conversation.

Custom Playlists: Whether it's Spotify or Apple Music, feel free to share your favorites with me to set the perfect mood.

III. RECEPTION - A. INTRODUCTIONS

The Mobs

We'll introduce your wedding party as the "Bridesmaids Mob" and "Groomsmen Mob" with high-energy theme songs and party props.

🎵 Intro Song:

- Bridesmaids Mob: Armed with party signs or light sticks.

🎵 Intro Song:

- Groomsmen Mob: Rocking cool sunglasses and party props.

🎵 Intro Song:

- Bride and Groom: Introducing you for the first time as a married couple!



PRO TIP

To really hype up the guests attending have both of the mobs above choreograph a specific dance to their entrance songs. I'll add the lights and dazzle!

III. RECEPTION - B. C. & D.

The "DJ Mistake"

For the ultimate surprise, I can perform a "DJ Mistake"—I'll scratch the music during your first dance as if I've messed up, only to drop a massive banger that signals everyone to rush the floor.

The Cocktail Food Burner

Immediately after your first dance, I'll keep the energy high with a mini-dance set to "burn off" those cocktail hour appetizers before dinner.

Sophisticated Dining

I believe calling table numbers over a mic sounds like a cheap cafeteria. If you're having a buffet, I'll coordinate with the venue staff to have them dismiss tables personally.



PRO TIP

The Dance Party Wedding Event requires a large playlist. Pick as many songs as you like for your Spotify or Apple Music Playlist. I will also monitor requests from guests.

III. RECEPTION - E. F. G. & H.

If you have multiple parents attending please let DJ Maxx know who to address them properly when it comes to making the announcements.

G. Bride and Groom Dance Trap:

The "Dance Trap"

This is my favorite transition. After your thank-you speech, you'll point to me and say, "The dance floor is open, let's party!". When you lead the way, your guests will follow your energy instantly.

PRO TIP

Usually Parent Dances are shorter than the 1st Dance. Please DJ Maxx know when to fade out your song.

III. RECEPTION - I. J. & K.

The Groom's Toss

We ditch the dated garter toss for something far more fun. I'll have the Groom toss a football, a gift card, or even a liquor box of your favorite spirit—it's a genius way to fill the floor with all the men attending.

Private Cake Cutting: To keep the party momentum from breaking, I often suggest a private cake cutting for your photographer so the dance floor never has to stop.

J. Bouquet - 🎵 Background Song:

If you don't have many single ladies attending we can make your Bouquet Toss for married women or you can dedicate your Bouquet to a very special person in your life.

K. Groom's Toss - 🎵 Background Song:



PRO TIP

If you want the party flow to continue on the dance floor you can have a Private Cake Cutting for photography.

III. RECEPTION - L. M. & N.

The "One More Song" Tradition

I always wrap the official event five minutes early. This is your cue to lead the crowd in chanting "ONE MORE SONG!" so we can end the night on an absolute peak.

PRO TIP

I usually end Wedding Events 5 minutes prior to the Official End of your Event. Be sure to yell "ONE MORE SONG!"
